***Type of trips***

<b>Cultural</b> <b>(\$550 - \$650)</b>	Discover a new culture with a short stay focused on identifying and knowing the urban differences between certain cities in North America.
<b>Exchange</b> <b>(\$500 - \$1500)</b>	A stay that offers a linguistic and cultural immersion. The students will exchange homes to offer the same experience.
<b>International</b> <b>(\$2700 - \$3000)</b>	Travel outside the continent to discover the linguistic, cultural and social differences of other cities and countries.
<b>Sports</b> <b>(\$375)</b>	A trip that will allow students to practice one or different sports, as well as attend matches or professional competitions.
<b>Specialized</b> <b>(\$400 - \$3350)</b>	Travel with a specific objective: integration, science, humanitarian, etc.
